

Ivers Preserve Now Open

The Ivers Preserve, accessed off of West Purchase Road, has been cleared and is open for all to enjoy. This 75 acre preserve runs along the east side of West Purchase Road for almost half a mile and then jogs east from West Purchase Road to the south end of the Bassett Preserve, creating 188 acres of open space. The Ivers Loop Trail is 1.1 miles and connects to the Bassett trails creating over 4 miles of area to hike. Tornado clean up work is underway on the Bassett Preserve and it will be open very soon.
